

This Protocol was Developed for Application at all Haiti Cheri Clinics

Goal: Safety of patients, staff, and community

Steps to Take: Follow recommendations and guidelines.

Increase remote communications with staff and patients

Limit services:

Urgent and emergency care

Medication refills

No elective services (classes, testing, etc.)

Outside waiting areas requiring physical distancing among patients

Screening at main entrance (gate)

All services provided in one area

Limited daily patient volume

Primary waiting area outside

Use of pre-spaced chairs inside

Everyone disinfects hands prior to entering exam rooms

Patient Flow: Patient enters via main gate with a mask (given one if without) and handwashing is required upon entry.

Screening will occur just inside main gate, in the open-air.

Once the patient has been registered, they will wait in the outdoor waiting area.

Challenges:	Corrective Approach:
Applying prevention principals.	Constant education, reminders, and supervision. Make masks available.

Increased PPE use w increased staff and activity.	Proper planning and keep stock at 1.5x more than expected.
All patients arrive in the morning.	Outdoor waiting areas. Patient scheduling.
Proximity during medical exams.	Ensure proper PPE, modify medical exams/procedures.

Future: Slow progression to full services
Maintain all other preventative protocol
